#### A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

#### Some Days Away

I am writing this from Munising. Last evening, I took my kayak out along the beautiful shoreline near Miner's Castle, part of the Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore. It was a beautiful evening with a glorious view. I thank God for all His gifts, especially, in moments like this, the beauty of creation. As I enjoy some time away, I am grateful for the many priests who have been covering for me this week, and I assure them and you of my prayers while I am away. Please keep me and our entire Church of the Resurrection/ Resurrection School team in your prayers. I feel so very blessed to be pastor here, and am increasingly excited about what God has in store for us.

#### Improvements

You may have noticed a few additions and changes on campus recently. As I mentioned in my bulletin article a few weeks ago, we are in the process of getting all the security cameras linked to the school office, including the playgrounds, parish hall, and school buildings. The new fencing between the schools has been installed, and will soon be connected with a security buzzer for use during school hours. This week, we have made some repairs in the parking lot, which will help us prevent a complete repaying for some years to come. Finally, if you haven't seen them yet, we have new banners that line Michigan Avenue in place of the old ones, which were very faded. The new ones show our Eucharistic/Monstrance branding, and name some of the values and priorities that we hold as a parish, school, and ministries: Healing, Faith, Family, Goodness, Beauty, Truth, and Mercy. We will soon be adding an outdoor crucifix in front of the elementary/preschool building. It is a great gift to be in the heart of Lansing. May we indeed be the salt, light, and leaven in our community, to help others come to know God's love, and to love others in Christ.

#### **Evening of Renewal/Prayer Meeting**


