And, "... you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Wednesday Evening Mass(es)

We will have our normal 6:00 p.m. Mass on Wednesday. It will be brief. There will be no adoration or confessions that evening, because of the 8th Grade Graduation, which will follow a special 6:30 p.m. Mass, shortly after the 6:00 p.m. Mass. (Sorry for the confusion, but graduation was set for Wednesday evening prior to us shifting our evening Mass from Tuesday to Wednesday.) Again, there will be two evening Masses Wednesday evening, but no confessions.

June is the Month of the Sacred Heart

This year, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 16. That next weekend, there will be an opportunity to consecrate your homes to the Sacred Heart of Jesus at 10:30 a.m. on June 18, after what is likely to be the 9:00 a.m. early Mass and before the 11:00 a.m. Mass. The ceremony takes about twenty minutes. The materials are prepared by *The Men of the Sacred Hearts*. We will need to have a count of those households who wish to participate

The "Great Commission"

Today in the Gospel, Jesus gives His final commands to his disciples. It's a command to us today just as it was to the apostles in the First Century: "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, *until the end of the age.* "The response of the early Church was obedience. When they were sent (as we are every time we come to Mass), they went. The Lord was faithful as they depended upon the Spirit, and they bore rich fruit for the Kingdom. I am excited about what God has in store for us this coming year, and hope and pray that as a parish we will bear fruit. My prayer for us as we anticipate the birthday of the Church next weekend is that we would strive to be winsome witnesses of the Gospel in our lives. May we learn more and more how to share the light of Christ with those around us. That is the essential mission of the Church. It's my mission. It's your mission. It's our mission. Let's call upon the Holy Spirit, and get ready!
