I am very glad that we have a school at our parish. The fruits of that ministry are growing, and we pray that all of our students, faculty, staff, and families will become the saints we are "making." Each year, we have an auction that allows members of the school, parish, and community to gather in order to celebrate the school, to enjoy food and fellowship, and to participate in a silent and live auction. This year's auction will be November 11 after the evening Mass. Join us in Mercy Hall. It is a great time and a worthy cause! The charge is nominal. \$10 per person, \$15 per couple, and \$ for seniors. We want you to come, so the cost is minimal. Please join us, and help us raise money to support families who want to partner with us for the education of their students. Thanks!

St. Casimir Rectory

Over the past six months, Fr. Jim Rolph and I have been talking with Dominic Iocco, President of Lansing Catholic High School, about renovating the old St. Casimir rectory and office into a large combined rectory for IHM & Resurrection, which would allow other priests to dwell there, as well, and for us to be able to host seminarians on internship and visiting priests in our own rectory. We have invited Fr. Vince to consider joining us, and also expect that when Fr. Joe Campbell is replaced as chaplain at LCHS (not saying that will happen anytime soon!), his replacement would live with us, as well. Lansing Catholic has purchased the entire campus from St. Mary Cathedral for a very nice price, and is in the process of resurfacing the gym floor for use as a practice facility and also potentially for competitions. Our finance council has approved expenditures to make some modifications of the old office areas into a more residential arrangement, with the plan to sell the current rectory on Jerome after I complete my move, which should be before the end of November. We will have three suites plus two guest rooms on the second floor, two guest rooms on the first floor, and a guest suite in the basement. This move will allow Fr. Jim and me to live together (with potentially two more priests on a regular basis), and allow us to host other guest priests and seminarians. I am looking forward to the transition, and ask your prayers as we finish up the last modifications. Should you have extra furniture that is in "gently use" as they say, for bedrooms and/or other combined living spaces, please let me know. We may be able to use it. Thanks!

Spiritual Warfare

It has been increasingly clear to me over the past few years that spiritual warfare has increased. We need to know that the enemy has already been defeated (ultimately), but that does not keep him from striving to "take back" ground that he has lost, and to harass and tempt and accuse us and those we love. Fr. Chad Ripperger, an exorcist, has written several books on the work of the enemy, and has offered a host of prayers that can be prayed by lay men and women, as well as prayers for the use of priests. I offer a few of the prayers for you to pray for yourselves and those you love should the prayers seem necessary or helpful. Again, I don't

share these prayers to scare anyone, but to encourage you. In Christ, all authority resides. And in Him, we too have authority. I have more authority as a priest, but you also, who have been baptized, have authority, and can pray these prayers. Should you be dealing with issues in your home or life that trouble you, please feel free to contact me for prayer and blessings. The following are taken from a book by Fr. Chad:

Prayer Against Every Evil

Almighty God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, Most Holy Trinity, Immaculate Virgin Mary, Angels, Archangels, and Saints of heaven, descend upon me. Please purify me, Lord, mold me, fill me with Thyself, and use me. Banish all the forces of evil from me, destroy them, vanguish them, so that I do Thy Holy Will. Banish from me all spells, witchcraft, black magic, malefice, ties, maledictions, and the evil eye; diabolic infestations, oppressions, possessions; all that is evil and sinful; jealousy, perfidy, envy; physical, psychological, moral, spiritual, diabolical ailments. Cast into hell all demons working these evils, that they may never again touch me or any other creature in the entire world. I command and bid all the powers who molest me by the power of God Almighty, in the Name of Jesus Christ our Savior, through the intercession of the Immaculate Virgin Mary to leave me forever, and to be consigned into the everlasting hell. Resurrection St. Vincent DePaul continues to serve our neighbors.

Our fiscal year ended September 2023 and within that timeframe we helped 1836 families; 1178 adults and 658 children.

We help people with variety of ways. One major way that we assist our neighbors is providing them with food. Much of our food is purchased from the Greater Lansing Food Bank at a cost of \$800-\$1000 per month.

Another source of food comes from the Meijer Simply Give program. This program is funded by donations from our parishioners.

The Lake Lansing Meijer gives us a time frame, this year it is October 1 through December 30th in which people can purchase a \$10 donation card (or more...in increments of \$10) at the store in the check-out lane. Meijer matches each donation, so a \$10 donation becomes \$20..etc. Meijer will DOUBLE MATCH on ONE day during the campaign...this year it's SATURDAY, DECEMBER 16th. We are encouraging cash donations be given directly to St. Vincent....then we will take donated funds to the store on the DOUBLE match day.

If you would like to make a donation, please put it in a separate envelope marked St. Vincent and place in the collection basket or drop it off at the office.

Your help allows us to be the helping hands of Jesus and to try to spread His love in this broken world in which we live.
