Ash Wednesday and Beyond

Lent is nearly here! There will be three Masses on Ash Wednesday at which we will distribute ashes. Come pray with us, as we begin our Lenten Journey together. The Masses will be held at 8:15 a.m., 12:00 noon, and 6:00 p.m. See the bulletin for other opportunities to pray more this Lent. Each Friday, we will pray the Stations of the Cross in the church at 6:30 p.m. Our plan will be to distribute ashes as usual. There are some parishes that are sprinkling ashes instead of imposing them with the exhortation. You'll have to call around to find a parish that will be giving that as an option.

Fasting for Him

As a reminder, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence. In the Church, the minimum required fast, which applies to those between the ages of 18 and 59, is to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals that do not add up to a full meal. The law of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) applies to those 14 years of age and older. *All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence*. Let me encourage you to see these days of fasting and abstinence as an invitation to deepen your hunger for God and to discipline the appetites of the flesh.

This weekend we will hold our annual second collection for Catholic Charities in the Lansing Area. There are envelopes and pledge forms in the pews and at the exits. Feel free to donate this weekend or take an envelope and send your donation after you take time to pray. I am pleased to see the changes that having the Alma Sisters of Mercy in charge of the medical clinic at Cristo Rey, and celebrate Mass at the chapel there every month. If you have questions or concerns about supporting this work, let me know. Thank you!

Witness to Hope (WTH) Funds Reallocation

The parish has been, as you know, anticipating an expanded renovation/restoration of the church. Back in 2017, we had originally proposed two major projects for which we raised funds: 1) The sanctuary renovation, which we estimated would cost \$750,000 and 2) Connecting the two school buildings, with a secure entrance, which we estimated would cost \$1,200,000. Since that time, we have made improvements to security on campus, and purchased a portable lift for accessibility purposes. The amount of our investments in the school over the past five years, including upgrades for security and accessibility, have totaled more than \$750,000. The improvements we have made have addressed most of the needs we highlighted in our preparation for the capital campaign. At the time of the original WTH campaign, I mentioned my desire eventually to get new lighting and increase the number of seats in the church, and so we have developed plans to that end. The cost of the expanded sanctuary and nave renovation is estimated to total approximately \$1,600,000. As a result,

we are hoping to repurpose WTH funds to cover the cost of this expanded renovation/restoration of the church.

Diocesan policy requires that we apprise you of this proposal. In coming weeks, we will be sending letters to all WTH donors who donated \$10,000 or more, requesting their approval to make this change. They will have 30 days to respond. Should any of them refuse to have their funds reallocated, we will offer to return the proportion of their donation we hoped to reallocate. For your information, our WTH fund at the end of December 31, 2023 totaled \$1,598,137. We have additional funds, including approximately \$100,000 in our "Sanctuary Beautification Fund," that we can apply to this project should some WTH donors decide they are not supportive of this reallocation. If you have concerns or questions about this, please let me know.

Men's Lenten Morning of Reflection (February 24)

Men and boys (middle school and up) are invited to our Lenten Morning of Reflection in Mercy Hall. The title is, *Fathers and Brothers in the Spiritual Battle*. I will be offering two talks, followed by discussion questions at tables. The first talk, "Fathers and Faith," addresses the indispensable role fathers play in forming their children as disciples and protecting them spiritually. The second talk, "Becoming a Band of Brothers," explores how good friends help us survive the spiritual battle. Our morning will conclude with Exposition in the church at 11:30, where confession will also be made available. Benediction will be at 12:30 for all those wishing to stay until that time. Deanery Mission March 3-5 at St. Thomas Aquinas

The Lansing Deanery will host its first Deanery Mission "The Holy Spirit: The Presence, the Power, and the Promise." It will be held March 3-5, 2024 from 6:30 p.m.-8:30 p.m. at St. Thomas Aquinas in East Lansing, with Dr. Mary Healy as the presenter. Here's the summary of what it will entail: At Pentecost the Holy Spirit came down on the apostles and changed their lives forever. Throughout the history of the Church, the Holy Spirit has empowered miracle-workers, emboldened martyrs, and imbued the saints with the grace of heroic virtue. But who is the Holy Spirit? In this three-evening mission we will not only explore the nature of the Holy Spirit, but call on Him to heal us, open us to our own Pentecost, and equip us to live lives of holiness and love. Please pray for those who will come to the mission, and I hope that you will consider joining us and inviting others to attend, as well. Thanks!
