I want to extend my gratitude to all parishioners who have responded well to the challenges of the renovation process, including all the changes to venues and times for confessions and Masses. Please keep praying for those who are navigating these various changes, and that our school, faculty, administration, parents, and students will finish the school year well.

Offertory Deficit

I suspect that some of this is due to a change in our normal Mass schedule, but we are running over \$25,000 behind compared with our budgeted amount. I know that many of you are giving faithfully and sacrificially, and I thank you. If you have not been giving as much as you believe the Lord is asking you to give, or you are able to increase your giving, this season of church renovation would be a helpful time for those increases. Many of you (including me) give using the online portal, and I encourage everyone who feels comfortable doing that to consider that option. Online giving or other automated giving options help ensure that the amount that parishioners plan to give is received each week, month, or year. As a parish, we are committed to using the funds that we are given with good stewardship, and I invite all of us to revisit our giving, and, for those who are able, to consider prayerfully increasing our giving. In any case, please pray for wisdom for all households, that we would do the Lord's bidding in this regard, trusting, as we are told in scripture that we cannot out-give God.


