Multiplication of the Loaves and Fish

Today in the Gospel, we hear John's account of the multiplication of the loaves and fish. All four Gospels include reference to this miracle, the only one recounted in all four. This miraculous meeting of the physical needs of His followers is a sign of Jesus being the fulfillment of the prophecy that another prophet would come and feed them bread from heaven as Moses had in the wilderness. Jesus takes what little we have and multiplies it for our good and the Glory of God.

Interlude from John's Gospel

This is the first of five weeks when the Gospel is taken from John. The next four weeks will focus on the "Bread of Life Discourse" from John's 6th Chapter. We will take time over the next few weeks to discuss the biblical roots and structure of the Mass, which culminates in the re-presentation of the saving sacrifice of Christ on the Cross. Just as it was in the 1st Century, the teaching about Christ's real presence in the Eucharist remains in the 21st Century a "difficult teaching." May we all be among those who believe what Jesus said and the Church continues to proclaim. My hope and prayer is that these weeks will be a blessing to us as we reflect on the structure and meaning of the Mass and meditate on the grace God gives us through the Eucharist, the Most Blessed Sacrament, Jesus, the Bread of Life.

Children's Business Fair

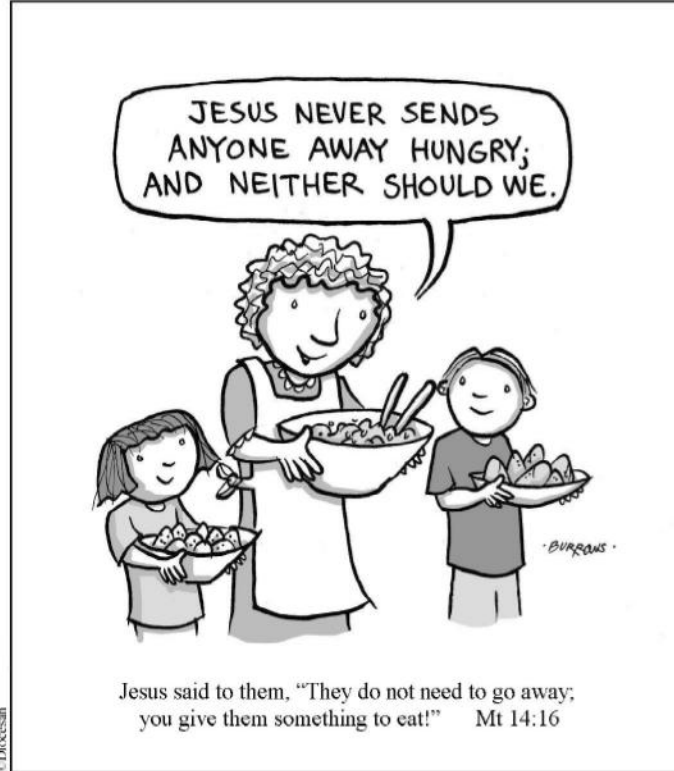
Saturday, August 3rd!
