If you are unable to fill a table with your own guests, we ask your cooperation in working with the Advent Tea Committee to seat other ladies at your table.

Please be advised: we request you serve only tea; no alcoholic beverages.

- Hostesses will be assigned a table based on the date their payment is received.
- Hostesses are responsible for decorating their table and serving tea. You are welcome to share your responsibilities with a friend or co-host.
- Hostesses may decorate their tables as simple or extravagant as desired. We suggest a smaller centerpiece as table space is limited. Decorate with items that enhance the spirituality of the season. Do not use secular items such as a snowmen, elves, or santas.
- OLGC will provide white tablecloths, tea sandwiches, dessert pastries, cream, and sugar.
- You will need to bring:
 1. Teapot/s
 2. Tea (bags or loose)
 3. Tea cups & saucers
 4. Luncheon-size plates (china or plastic)
 5. Silverware as desired
 6. Napkins
 7. Centerpiece that includes a candle to light

The Social Hall will be open from 11:30 am to 5:00 pm on Friday, December 2 for setting tables. Park your car by the door off the kitchen (accessed by the lower driveway of the Church) to unload via the kitchen entrance. Members of the Advent Tea Committee will assist if you need help.
