#### The Eucharist: Covenant


Ex. 3: 13-14


#### The Eucharist: Covenant

#### The Eucharist : Sacrifice

Ex. 24: 1-5

He built at the foot of the mountain an altar and twelve sacred stones for the twelve tribes of Israel. Then, having sent young men of the Israelites to offer burnt offerings and sacrifice young bulls as communion offerings to the LORD, Moses took half of the blood and put it in large bowls; the other half he splashed on the altar.

#### The Eucharist : Sacrifice

Ex. 24: 6-9

Taking the book of the covenant, he read it aloud to the people, who answered, "All that the LORD has said, we will hear and do." Then he took the blood and splashed it on the people, saying, "This is the blood of the covenant which the LORD has made with you according to all these words."

Gen. 22: 7


"Father, here are the fire and the wood, but where is the sheep for the offering?"

Jn. 19: 34


But one soldier thrust his lance into his side, and immediately blood and water flowed out.

#### The Eucharist: Sacrifice


Jn. 19: 40-41




# How do I see the sacrifice of Jesus as a gift of love?

## The Eucharist: Thanksgiving


