Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka



Happy Fathers' Day to all you dads!! On this day, may you turn to St. Joseph and God and offer thanks for the blessings you have as a father. May you also turn to them and ask them for the continued guidance and inspiration you need to be strong and effective in your vocation. (Of course, don't forget to thank your wife and children also!) You certainly have an awesome task, being a father, in

today's world. Our youth, especially young men, need good role models of men who are strong in their faith, caring for their wife and family, guided by honesty, integrity, and faithfulness in life. I think the testimonies and words of many children at their father's funeral demonstrate the lasting and enduring effects of a good father in a child's life. It is especially inspiring to hear how positively a father's strong Christian faith, which was integrated in his daily life, was at the core of who some dads were. Dads – don't be afraid or ashamed to speak about your faith in front of your children. Don't be afraid to pray with them. As the years progress, it just very well may be the greatest gift you can give them!! God bless you all. So here is our prayer for you this day:

*God our Father, we praise you and bless you for the life you have given us, through your saving love, revealed in Jesus your Son. Through Christ you have revealed yourself as a loving father who provides for us all.*

*Look with love upon our father and bless him with your love. Deepen his love for his wife and family and make us one in love with all your holy people as we proclaim your mighty deeds and sing your praises. We offer your praise and glory through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.*

**\*\* Fuel the Mission.** That is the purpose of the Catholic Services Appeal. It is an appropriate reminder of what we need to do each year to keep the momentum going to bring Christ to others. The "others" includes not only our neighbors or other individuals who are seeking Christ in their life. It also includes each one of us because we benefit from the more than 170 programs, ministries and services funded by the CSA. Nonetheless, when we all pool our resources, the mission of Jesus, to provide the material and spiritual needs of people in southeast Michigan, is achieved. (It is also good to note that all funds given to the CSA is administered and overlooked by a lay council and no funds have been, are, or will be used to settle any lawsuits of any kind.)

Here is the bottom line. We have been successfully meeting our target the past few years because of your understanding to support the mission of the Church. The many gifts and generosity help us exceed the target with the excess returned to the parish and likewise providing funds for our own parish ministries

### Stewardship Thoughts

The theme of today's readings is God's great love for His people. In the Book of Exodus, God calls Moses to remind the ancient Israelites of the blessings He bestows on those who keep His covenant. St. Paul, in his Letter to the Romans, describes God's love in how we are reconciled to Him through the death of His son, Jesus Christ. And in St. Matthew's Gospel, Jesus sends the Apostles out to the people of Israel to Proclaim the Kingdom of Heaven. Even that long ago, Jesus was concerned there was a shortage of messengers to carry the Good News when He said: The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. **Fall Sport Registration Period May 6 - June 30, 2023** (Sports offered: Girls Volleyball Grades 4-8) fee \$200.00/ player.

**Winter Sport Registration Period: May 6 - September 30, 2023** (Sports offered: Boys/ Girls Basketball) Grades 3-8 fee \$200.00/ player. Depending on # of players registered 3rd/4th graders may play in an instructional basketball program vs CYO.  
Grades K-2 intramural program \$125.00/ player.  
Grades 2-8 "Club" Cheerleading \$125.00/ player.


**Spring Sport Registration Period:** (Sports combined w/ St Joan and St Paul: Girls Softball, Boys Baseball) Grades 5-8 fee TBD.

Men's Club Fee: \$25 per family.

**Sports physical exam** is required each year to be eligible to participate in CYO athletics or the 3/4 grade instructional basketball program. **The physical must be dated by the doctor after April 15, 2023.** No student will be allowed to try out for any sport without having a sports physical on file with the Athletic Department. There are no exceptions to this requirement.
