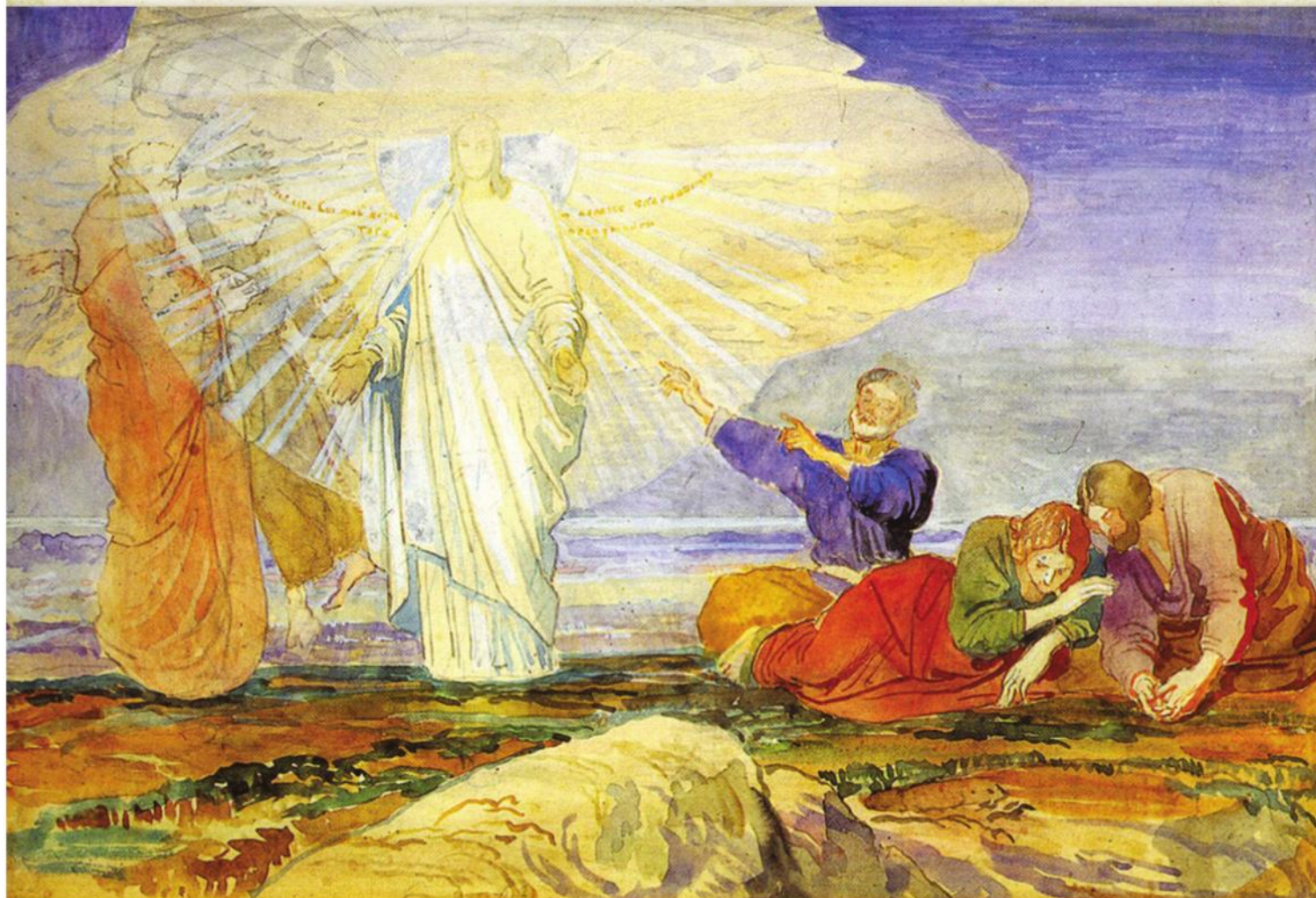

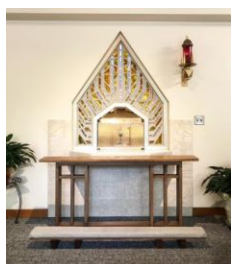

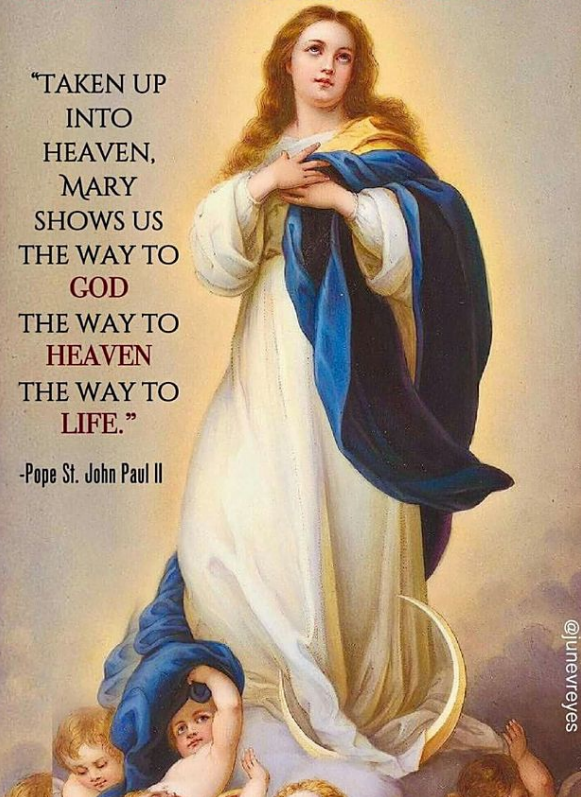

### What We Believe: The Beauty of the Catholic Faith

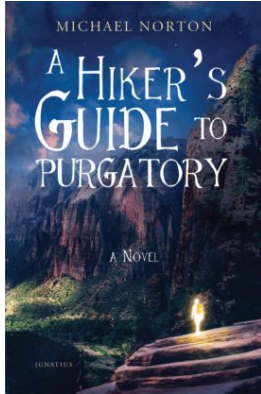
What is the Catholic Church all about? What does it mean to be Catholic? What do Catholics actually believe?

+ You are schedule approx. one time per month (we are trying to schedule 2 ministers each week so you would only have to visit 4 homes)

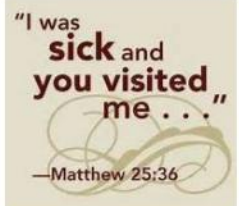
+ Time involved depends on how many homes we visit.

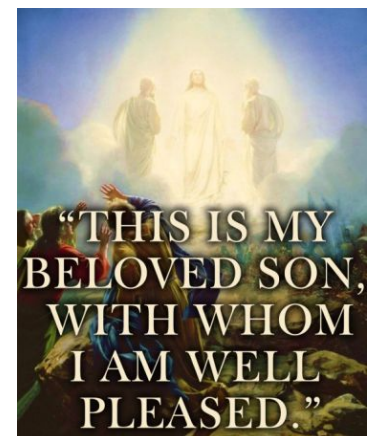
