
# Our Lady Star of the Sea

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.


#### PARISH REGISTRATION





In today's Scripture readings from the Book of the prophet Isaiah and St. Matthew's Gospel, God does not operate according to human expectations, and His abundant generosity is never outdone. In Isaiah, God states, For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways, says the Lord. In the Gospel, Jesus narrates a parable about heaven being like a landowner who invites laborers to his vineyard at different times, but generously pays them all equally at the end of the day. God gives us His abundant gifts to share with the poor and needy, because Jesus proclaims, the last will be first, and the first will be last. St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians reminds us that Christ will be exalted through our productive toil. 
