Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka Our <u>Prayer Ministry</u> has been a wonderful addition to our parish life. These "prayer ministers" are really prayer warriors, praying for and with those who come to them after Mass, invoking and petitioning the Lord to hear these prayers, according to His will. Yet at the same time, the minister is especially moved to see and witness of power of Jesus in their life and in the lives of our parishioners. I have heard from those on the receiving end of the prayer ministry the peace or calm that came over

them after praying together.

I share with you some insights about this ministry from one of the coordinators, Midge Culos. *Answering a Call...*

It was just about a year ago that our parishioners were invited to discern the prospect of becoming trained as a Prayer Minister. To our delight, sixteen people expressed interest and were subsequently trained to pray with people following all Masses. Soon we'll be extending this opportunity once again, but, before we do, we thought we'd ask our current Prayer Ministers to share a little insight regarding their personal experience with being a Prayer Minister. Below are just some of their responses:

"Being a member of the prayer ministry has been fulfilling in many ways. It is comforting to be part of a group you can pray with and pray for yourselves and others who are suffering. A group that truly believes in the power of prayer is a blessing."

"Praying as sisters and brothers, with Jesus in our center, giving ourselves up to God and praising and acknowledging His great love and mercy, is that wondrous lifeline of hope and peace that rises above and surpasses all other sources we seek. When we ask with a heart that believes that God will always do what is good and Jesus always walks with us, it is like the feeling you have when you have found and placed that final little puzzle piece and the puzzle becomes complete-you don't walk alone ever."

"Being a part of the Prayer Ministry has been inspirational to me in a number of ways. I've always been active in the Parish but this ministry has given me a more personal view of individuals and their need for prayer. EVERYONE needs prayer and our outreach gives them a safe place to say their needs out loud. We are so blessed to be a part of this."



Our lectors find that participation in the Lector Ministry gives them an increased understanding of and appreciation for Sacred Scripture.


Lectors are normally scheduled to serve about once a month at the Mass they normally attend.




