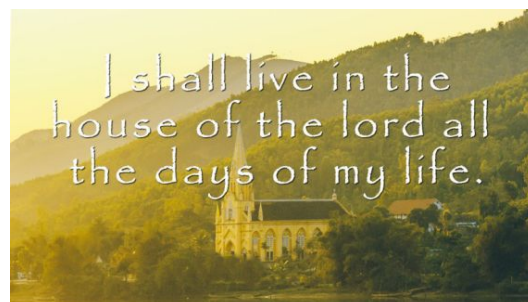


Mass of Remembrance

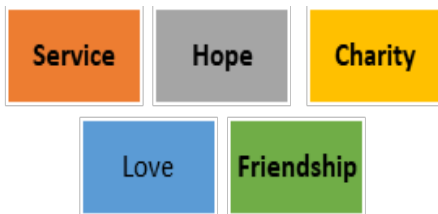
