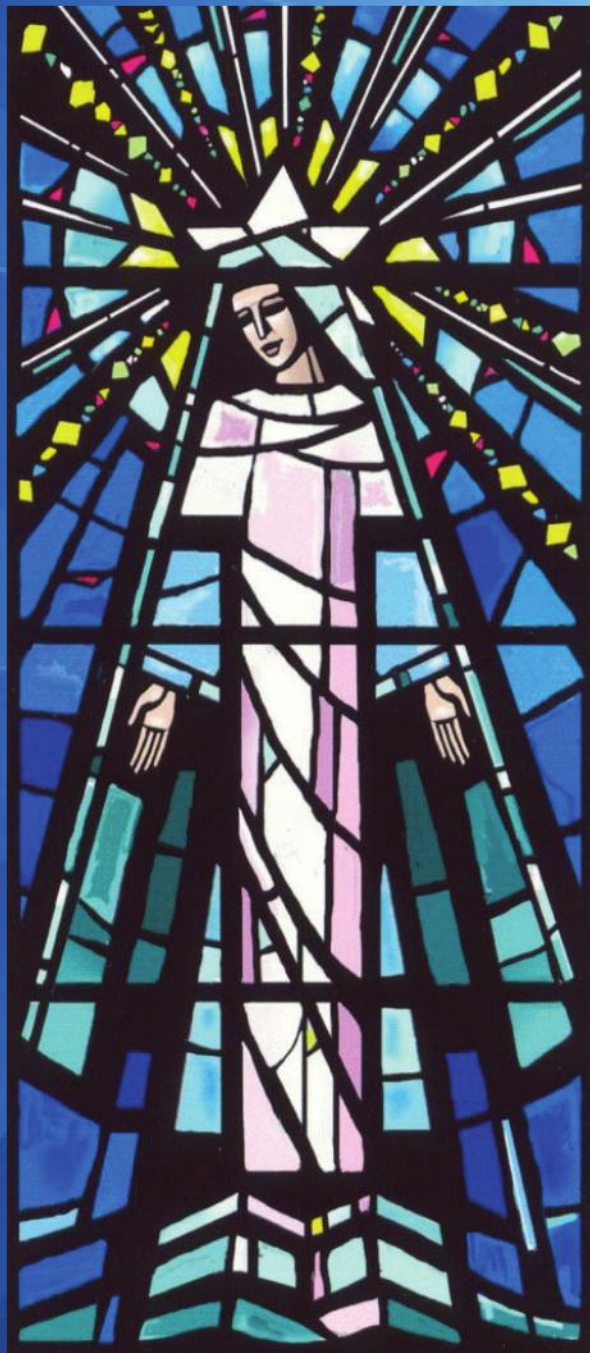

### ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

### MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

**Adults over 21** need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Now that the Christmas Season is over and we are once again beginning Ordinary Time in our liturgical calendar. There is certainly nothing "ordinary" about this time. Yes, in our daily life we are back to more of our normal routines. There is nothing all that ordinary, however, with our celebrations of the liturgy. We once again get to encounter the many wonderful mysteries and miracles of Christ as he went about his "ordinary" life of bringing people to God for the sake of building God's Kingdom on earth and preparing that eternal home for his disciples in the hereafter!

The Mass is one of the great gifts the Church has to give to the world. It is life giving to all who come and open their hearts and minds. What more could we ask for as we recall the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus as he gives us his very Body and Blood!

As we begin this new year I ask you to be renewed in your participation in the celebration of the Mass and help others to likewise participate as well. We are entering the last half of this year of the year of the Eucharist in the parish and it is a good time to renew the significance of the Eucharist and the Mass in our faith life. Given the ebb and flow of our life, the challenges and difficulties, we need to stay connected to Jesus not only in our personal prayer but also with one another in a community of faith. Our community is filled with so many faith filled people who give testimony to the action of Jesus in their life. Knowing, or even imagining, the faith of those around you during Mass can be a source of inspiration.

Yes we encounter living presence of Jesus in His Body and Blood, especially in the act of communion. We also are drawn in the mystery of the celebration through our prayers, the readings, and the music. I encourage you to open a hymnal and please join in singing. Mass and its music is not a performance to sit and listen to others but a prayer for all to join. (Remember: he who sings prays twice!) We have great acoustics that help to fill the church with wonderful sounds if everyone will join in singing. It also enlivens the liturgy and fills the spirit of those participating. Listen to the prayers (those at the beginning, the prayer over the gifts and the post communion prayer). Listen to the various parts of the Eucharistic prayer. What strikes you anew? What phrases have you not heard before? How is it that you can offer your life with that of the bread and wine offered that is changed into the Body and Blood of Jesus? At the end of every Mass we are encouraged to go forth and announce the Kingdom. What is it from that Mass can you take and offer to others? This is our mission. To take Christ and bring his life and love to others.

**\*\* You often hear us mention at Mass about adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, What is it? First if flows from Mass take a large consecrated host, Christ himself. Second, it is simply spending time with Jesus in his presence. You can sit quietly and allow the Lord to speak to you. You can also pray your own treasury of prayers. If you have never spent time in adoration, give it a try. Start first with 5 or ten minutes and then gradually add more time as you get comfortable with the Lord. It is also a great stress reliever, as you simply place all you have and all you are before the Lord. Let Him take your burdens!**

**\*\* Our school Open House is coming up in a few weeks. A great time to bring some prospective families through our "school of excellence." A great school providing great education and formation in a great parish community. Have your neighbors and other interested parties check it out during the Open House or any time!!**

See you at Mass and let the Lord amaze you with his presence!

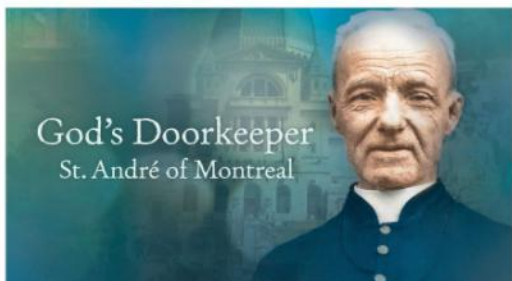

## Stewardship Thoughts

Today's Scripture passages from the First Book of Samuel and St. John's Gospel express the common topic of accepting God's will by responding to His call. Our vocation is the Lord's plan for our lives. St. Paul, in his First Letter to the Corinthian community, professes we are all members of the Body of Christ and temples of the Holy Spirit, *that you are not your own. For you have been purchased at a price.* Further in First Corinthians, Paul indicates that through the power of the Holy Spirit, we may be given special spiritual gifts — unique gifts which we are commissioned to use to serve the Lord and carry out His divine plan. These gifts in turn, can lead to prayer, meditation, and contemplation — to conversion of mind to heart, and help the discerning steward discover his or her vocational call from the Lord. This call may be to the priesthood or religious life, to marriage, the permanent diaconate, or single life. Are we, like Eli, Samuel, or the Apostles, Peter, John, and Andrew, open to the Lord's prompting in our lives? 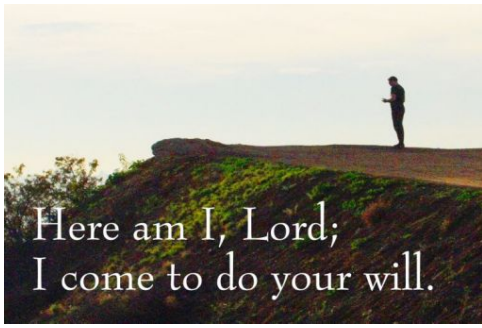
