The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Hopefully you have seen the notice in this paper about our upcoming Eucharistic Procession from St. Paul church to Star of the Sea church on Sunday, June 2, the feast of Corpus Christi. I am very much looking forward to this procession and celebration. I hope many of you will participate in some way. You can walk all the way or part of it. You can be here at Star when the procession ends.

You can even just be on the sides and witness it as it passes by.

Another way to not only enter into the preparation for this day but learn more about the Eucharist through the lives of others and understand how the Eucharist changed their life for the better. Who doesn't want that?

Available in our Gathering space is book called, <u>33 Days to Eucharistic Glory</u>. It is designed as a pilgrimage, leading you to the Eucharist. As the introduction says, "This isn't just another book .It is an invitation to participate in a scared journey - a spiritual pilgrimage. It's a guide that will lead you to the essence of what it means to be Catholic...and it will change your life in the most marvelous of ways."

"Eucharistic Consecration will take your spiritual life to unimaginable new levels, but it will also energize the way your participate in relationships, ignite a new curiosity about yourself and others; transform the way you think about money and things; re-focus your professional life; liberate you from many of your fears, doubts, and anxieties; make you aware of the hopes and dreams God has placed in your heart; and breathe new life into your appreciation for the genius of Catholicism."

I ask you to consider making this "pilgrimage." You can do it in the luxury of your own home at your own time. It will probably take no more than 15 minutes a day, a step-by-step guide for each day. The weeks are divided up: The Eucharist and the Pilgrim; The Eucharist and the Saints; The Eucharist and You; The Eucharist and History; The moment of Surrender.

I am asking that you start is pilgrimage on May 1, completing it on June 2 with our procession and celebration.

Adult and Children versions of the books are available in the Parish Office or the gathering Space, (suggested donation \$10). You can purchase the companion journal in the Parish office for \$15. Books are also available on Amazon and see the option for downloading on your Kindle for less than \$9. Amazon also has the companion journal and the Childrens version. I strongly encourage your participation in this "pilgrimage," especially as we are still in this time of Eucharistic Revival.

May your week be filled with the knowledge of the deep love Jesus has for you!



I never tire of this quote from Mother Luisita: 'Don't feel alone because you're not. Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament wants to be your confidant, your friend, your consoler.' Whether desolation or consolation, the reality remains — Jesus is present in the Holy Eucharist. Go to Him, receive Him, let Him fill your heart with His peace, joy and love.

Make a personal commitment of a day to pray one hour per week in His Eucharistic presence.





Stewardship Thoughts

In St. John's Gospel, Jesus proclaims, *I am the Good Shepherd*, giving us the beautiful image of Him as shepherd attending to us, His flock. In contrast to the hired hand that bolts at the first sign of trouble, Jesus will never desert His flock. However, he is concerned for *other sheep that do not belong to this fold*. St. Peter, in the Acts of the Apostles, reminds us that *there is no salvation through anyone else* but Christ. In St. John's First Letter, he affirms that we are *children of God* through the great love of the Father for us. And yet, he observes that the world does not know Him. Evangelization is the consistent theme in these readings. One way to take the Catholic faith to the streets is to join a local St. Paul Street Evangelization team, or to volunteer at a local soup kitchen or homeless shelter serving our less fortunate brothers and sisters.


