ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office or online at OLSOS.org. Please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Sometimes it is difficult to understand some of the concepts or mysteries that we celebrate in the Church. Pentecost and the power of the Holy Spirit can be one of those mysteries. Maybe this little "word picture" can be of assistance.

"I have a glove here in my hand. The glove cannot do anything by itself, but when my hand is in it, it can do many things. True, it is not the glove, but my hand in the glove that acts. We are gloves. It is the Holy Spirit in us which is the hand, who does the job. We have to make room for the hand so that every finger is filled.

The question on Pentecost is not whether God is blessing our own plans and programs but whether we are open to the great opportunities to which his Spirit calls us.

Once the Lord said to a faithful evangelist, 'You have been working for me with the utmost sincerity for seven years. All that time I have been waiting for the moment that I could start to work through you'." (Corrie ten Boom)

Let us be mindful this week of the Spirit's action and power in our life.

Come, Holy Spirit! Penetrate the heart of your faithful; kindle in them the fire of your love. Amen.

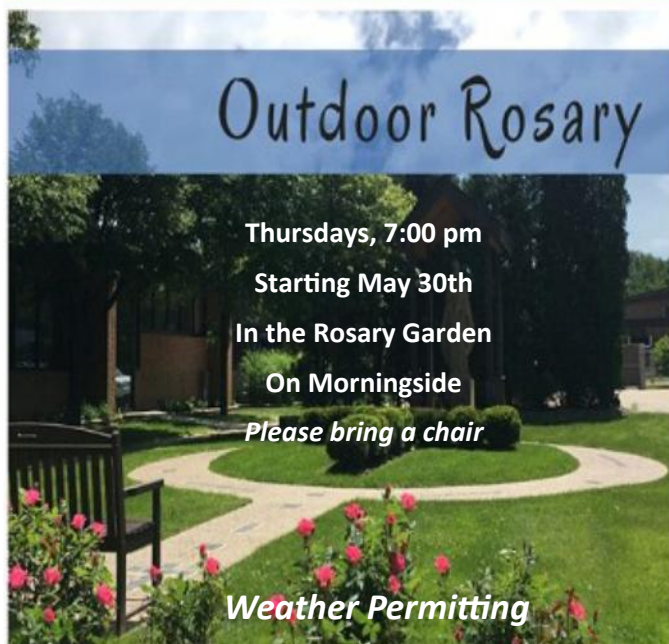

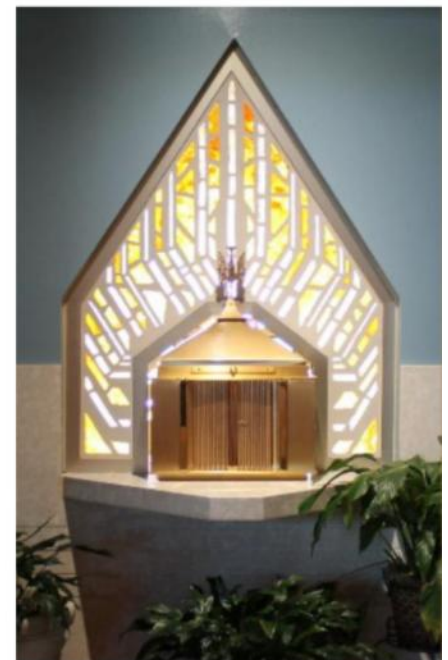

EASTSIDE CATHOLIC EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION Frequently Asked Questions

What is the procession route?

The procession will begin with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at St Paul on the Lake Catholic Church. The faithful will proceed along Lake Shore Road and conclude with Benediction at Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church.

Do I have to walk the whole way?

All are invited to the 12:00 noon Mass at Saint Paul on the Lake Catholic Church, after which we will start the procession.

Recognizing that not everyone may be able to walk the entire route, we have a few spots where participants can join the procession,

- Lake Shore and Moross
- Lake Shore and Woodland Shores
- Ballantyne and Cook Road

Approximate times when we will be at these intersections will be posted closer to the event.

Procession will end at Our Lady Star of the Sea with Benediction, followed by fellowship in the Pointe.

Will we process even if it rains?

Yes, we will. If it rains, the Eucharistic procession will continue as planned. Please bring an umbrella and or raincoat.

Stewardship Thoughts

On this Pentecost Sunday, the Scripture readings reveal the powerful works of the Holy Spirit in the early Christian community. At Pentecost, the Church "is made manifest to the world" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1076). In other words, it is at Pentecost that the Catholic Church is born. In the Acts of the Apostles, we observe the power and authority that the Holy Spirit bestows on the disciples through the symbols of wind and tongues of fire. In St. John's Gospel, Jesus gives His followers the gifts of the Spirit: peace and the power to forgive sins. In his First Letter to the faith community at Corinth, St. Paul encourages them to strive for unity and to acknowledge one another's gifts, service, and works given by the Most Holy Trinity as one Body in Christ. (Likewise in his letter to the Galatians, Paul encourages them to live in the spirit, not in the flesh.) As faith-filled stewards, what God-given gifts and services do we offer weekly at the altar of the Lord to uplift our parish communion? In a spirit of evangelization, are we building up the Body of Christ by inviting our brothers and sisters to a personal relationship with our Lord and Savior? 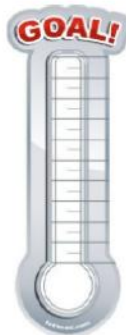

What is the Catholic Services Appeal?
