Confirmed in the Spirit:

1. Opening Prayer (read together)	2. Personal Connection
A Prayer for the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit Lord Jesus Christ, send down your Spirit upon me. When I am uncertain, grant me wisdom. When I am confused, grant me understanding. When I am ignorant, grant me knowledge. When I am wandering, grant me counsel. When I am afraid, grant me fortitude. When I am separated from you, grant me piety. When I am selfish, grant me the fear of the Lord.	Parents- Reflect on then discuss the following: When have you felt the Holy Spirit guide you in your life? How did you know it was the Holy Spirit? After sharing, ask your student: Have you ever felt the Holy Spirit guide you? How might being sealed with the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit at your Confirmation help your spiritual life?
I ask for an outpouring of your Spirit with all of these gifts in your name. Amen.	

3. Activity

A Roll of the Dice

For this activity, you will need a **six-sided die** and one **gameboard**. A gameboard can either be printed (a copy to print is available at the end of this document) or can be drawn on a blank piece of paper.

Directions:

- Form two teams (if playing with two people, one person teams are fine).
- When it is your turn, roll the dice. Each number on the dice represents a different question that must be answered (see chart below).
- On your turn, you must add a new answer to that question on the gameboard. If you add a new answer, give your team one point, however, if you cannot provide a new answer to the question, the other team gets to try. If they answer the question, they get a point and your turn is over.
- The next team rolls the dice, answers a question, etc.
- Once a category is complete, if a team rolls that question's number, they get an automatic reroll.
- Continue to play until the gameboard is full *OR* neither team can answer any additional questions *OR* at least three rounds of play.

- 3. Open *Confirmed in the Spirit* to pg. 53-56 and read "Unwrapping the Gifts of the Holy Spirit." Which of the seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit help you to *know* God's will and which Gifts help you *do* God's will?
- 4. In the *Catechism for Adults,* read "The Mission and Witness of the Confirmed" (p. 207-209). Once confirmed, how will the seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit guide your life both inside the Church and beyond?
- 5. Confirmation seals you with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit which will help you discern God's mission for your life. How will you make the time and space to listen to God's will in your life now and in your future? Give one specific example.
