CARPOOL REMINDERS

- Please use patience while in line. Sometimes it's more difficult for a child to come to school or there might be several children in the car that need to grab their coats & bags before exiting. Please do not drive around a car that is still unloading. We do have children that get out on both sides of the vehicle and we want to keep all children safe.
- Please make sure your child is ready to exit your car. Make sure their shoes are on, bags & coats are in a place for them to grab or you to pass through the window.
- When pulling away from the carline, be sure to look both ways! Morning carpool, people can be walking in from the parking lot. Afternoon carpool, cars can be coming from both directions by the sidewalk.
- Please try to avoid being on your phone when you get to the front of the line. Sometimes, we might have a message to pass on or explain something that happened during the day.
- I know it's exciting to the children to sit up front, I am OK with it as long as they are sitting in the seat. Not in your lap or have their hands on the wheel like they are driving. This can be very dangerous for everyone.
- If your child is having a bathroom emergency, feel free to pull out of the line and walk your child to the bathroom. You can walk them back up to us at the front while you retrieve their tote bag from the car.

- Fasting: We can GIVE UP something we really like to eat or do (candy, pizza, playing video games), to help us think more like Jesus.
- Almsgiving: We can help others by cleaning up our toys, carrying a bag for grandma, sweeping the floor, to help us be more like Jesus.
