

Children in our four year old classes (PreK) are provided with a variety of activities that develop age appropriate learning and kindergarten readiness. Following directions, listening to the teacher and caring for own belongings are important skills learned for kindergarten.

Opportunities for growth are found in teacher directed activities that include counting, sorting, matching, patterning, graphing, recognizing numbers, letters and rhyming words, developing vocabulary, recognizing and writing names and surrounding children in meaningful printed words. Our 4's classes use Handwriting Without Tears (proper pencil grip and letter formation) for fine motor skill development and Zoophonics (sound recognition) for language and literacy development.

The daily schedule includes morning work, question of the day, center time, circle time, small group instruction, art projects, science exploration, story time, music, playground time and more. Children bring a lunch daily.

Our four – year – old program choices are:

Four days a week: Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

Five days a week: Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday/Friday

Hours are 9:30 am to 1:00 pm
