Our team has taken the past school year to research some trends among Gen Z students, to listen to feedback from parents and volunteers in our community, and most of all to pray. As a result of this research and the promptings of the Holy Spirit in our prayer, we will intentionally focus on four pillars of youth ministry.

Nothing we do matters if we aren't open to the Holy Spirit moving in our ministry. By focusing on prayer as its own pillar we hope to multiply our ability to build up teens to be fully alive, rooted in Christ, reflecting His love and mercy.



Year 1

 Include teens regularly in petitions Sunday Masses- whole community pray for YM

Year 2

- 2-3 leaders to initiate and host prayer events
 - Communicate prayer requests about teens and events in real time
 - Create space for in person prayer gatherings

Year 3-5

- Host training in intercessory prayer for community, especially teens
- Prayer team hosts Sunday night groups or create running schedule of prayer teams to be on-site praying while YM meets

Family Support

We desire to foster deep conversations around faith in our families' homes. Additionally, we hope for families to build community at St. Peter Chanel and experience life events with others inside and outside of our doors. We want them to feel confident in asking for help, and to value their relationship with God above all other relationships in their lives.



Year 1

- Encourage all SPC staff to help us connect parents and family members to existing opportunities at the parish
 - o Small Groups, Alpha, Retreats, Bible Studies, etc.

Year 2

- Build a leadership team to help grow into later goals
 Year 3
 - Grow into small groups that meet at the same time as youth ministry or when their schedules allow

Volunteer Formation

The ideal Core Member has a vibrant personal prayer life, a growing relationship with Christ, a strong sense of humility, a desire to understand and enter into teen culture, a strong backbone to discipline with love when necessary, and a commitment to share God's love with the students in our ministry and each other. We are striving to empower adults to meet such a high call.



Year 1

- Current team begins recruiting other adults to mentor and accompany teens as small group leaders, content planners, and more
- Monthly gatherings for continual growth

Year 2-4

 Equip Core Members to create nights for teens to gather and grow outside of Sundays; including planning, execution, and follow up

Year 5

- Robust opportunities for teens and Core to develop gifts like intercessory prayer and healing
- Grow additional teams of support, ex. prayer, outreach,

Teen Discipleship

By developing the ways we approach teen discipleship, we hope to allow our teens to be saints while they're here; pursuing a relationship with Christ fervently and joyfully.







Year 1

- Teens inviting peers to participate in events
- Launch teen leadership team (Teen Missionaries)
- Encourage teen involvement in liturgical ministries
 - Ushers, Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers

Year 2

- Core Members mentoring teen leadership teams
- Selection process for a junior Missionary team
- Develop and mentor teens to grow in relationship with Christ and share that with their peers

- Growing participation in Sunday night Youth Group to the highest we have seen in many years
- Initiating monthly Nights of Worship for teens and their family to pray with Jesus in the Eucharist together
- Empowering Core Members to create and host summer events
- Launching Teen Missionaries, a new leadership initiative
